VOLUNTEER NEEDS:

All volunteers will receive training in the area they are volunteering.

Zoo Crew Leaders & Assistant Crew Leaders do not have to prepare anything, but just come each day ready to join in the VBS fun! The crew leaders and assistants guide their crew (10 kids) through each activity and station. They are to help assist as needed in each station and interact with the children engaging them in discussion about each activity and reemphasizing the main Bible Point for each day. (12 leaders and 12 assistants are needed) Training will be provided.

Untamed Games Assistant-Assist the Untamed Games Leader in each game/activity. These will be outside as weather permits. They are to help engage the children in the planned games for the day. (3 are needed)

Critter Café Snack Assistant-Assist the Critter Café leader in the preparation and serving of simple snacks to each group. (6 are needed)

Registration-Help register children the first two days of VBS that have not preregistered. (4 are needed)

Greeter-Help welcome and direct those coming to VBS in the morning and at pick up time.

The excitement is building!

THANK YOU! THANK YOU to all who have supported the New Playground Initiative at Wesley Memorial! Gifts to date total \$95,620, which includes a \$40,000 MATCH from the church. Because we are SO CLOSE to our \$100,000 goal for Phase I, the Playground Visioning Team was given the go-ahead in May to meet with Madelyn Russ of Grounds4Play (designer of our younger play area) and Todd McDuffee of Carolina Parks & Play (designer of our preschool/older area). Timeline: younger play area (Level 1) will be developed first, with expected installation in August. Equipment selected for the older play area (Level 3) is a custom-made order. It will take a bit longer, with a Fall installation date.

The \$100,000 Phase I Project includes fees for demolition of old equipment, fine grading, drainage system, unload of equipment at delivery, and the project-build. (So many details to plan!) Required borders will surround "drop-zone" areas and contain mulching. Because \$100,000 includes "entire project " expenses beyond solepurchase of new equipment, we will continue to seek gifts designated for Playground in order to add side-pieces. All side pieces have been pre-selected and will enhance our play park as the longrange vision unfolds. Side pieces will not be part of Phase I. Examples of side pieces to be added over time include picnic tables, park benches, a swing set, climbing rocks, a hillside chute slide, and a welcoming entrance archway sign with scripture. Families who may be interested in gifting any of these side pieces are invited to contact the Susans for the individual pricing.
