Wesley Memorial Supports Partner Agencies and Ministries

Wesley Memorial's annual operating budget includes a block of money for to support ministries that extend our work and enable us to live in ways that transform the world. This year both the Local Missions Team and Global Missions Team received \$21,750 to distribute to partner agencies. This is in addition to \$1,000 to support the local CROP Walk, \$8,000 to support our new local mission initiatives, and \$5,000 to host another Stop Hunger Now event.

Each team receives funding requests from many agencies. This year we had over \$56,000 in requests for local ministries. After prayerful discernment and much discussion, the Local Mission Team recommended the following allocations that were approved by Church Council.

JULY WORSHIP SCHEDULE

Last summer (2012) we offered all 4 worship services all summer long and the average attendance was considerably lower than the summer of 2011 when we offered only 1 worship service in July and August. A great many people have suggested a reduction in the number of services during the summer months, so the Church Council, Worship Team, and Clergy have all agreed to offer two services during July.


