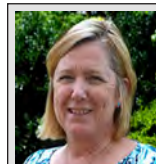

Chancel Bells ring for worship on Easter Sunday, April 16. They are ringing a joyous and celebratory piece called "Resurrection."

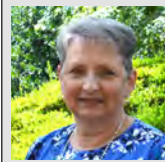

Dear Friends of Wesley Memorial:

I can find no words that adequately express the depth of gratitude I feel for God's blessing of my life-long career at Wesley Memorial. 40 years. How can it be that 40 years have gone by so swiftly for me here? Beginning as Lead Teacher of Kindergarten Fives; followed by 15 years as Assistant Director under the outstanding leadership of the late Jean Bowman (my "apprenticeship"), and now completing my 18th year as full Director.

I believe that a school administrator of longevity should have the wisdom and grace to recognize when the time has come to step away in order to allow for that school's expanded growth through a new generation of ideas. Therefore, I announce my decision to retire effective June 9, 2017. This careful decision comes after many prayerful conversations with God, as well as with the Reverend Dr. Al Ward, Senior Pastor, and Susan Hedrick, Chair of the WMS Board of Directors. The time is simply right - - for the church, for Wesley Memorial School, and for me personally.

I am so proud of Wesley Memorial School. We can all celebrate that our school is on solid ground financially, and enrollment at full capacity with waiting lists for Fall. The positive reputation of WMS in our community is second-to-none. Current staff of 28 teachers share amazing expertise, experience, and love. And . . . I can never say enough about the administrative partnership that I have shared with Susan Kelley. I am confident that the philosophy and values of WMS will remain in capable hands within a new administrative structure. WMS has been well-readied for this transition.

It is my hope that as I matured in this field of early childhood education, I have radiated the JOY and PASSION which I have felt for the thousands of relationships with children, families, teaching colleagues and church staff who have crossed my path. I have loved, and still love, coming to Wesley Memorial every day. I am especially appreciative for the creative license entrusted in me by the church. It has allowed this Director to follow NAEYC accreditation paths, to integrate innovative curriculum, to foster high professional standards for teaching staff, and to explore new possibilities in design of our playgrounds. My journey in ministry at Wesley Memorial School has truly been a dream career. My heart will be forever thankful.
